We also think the added 50 laps will make strategy a more important part of the race.”

Fourteen different drivers have stood in Easter Bunny Victory Lane, and the list is a who's-who of modern Super Late Model racing and beyond. Keen went on to state, “We feel that our 2026 season should assist the drivers and owners that enter most of the races but don't run up front all the time. So, in this race, we will be giving the 10th-place finisher a set of tires for their next PASS race to help with expenses.”

Post time is 2:30pm on Saturday, March 14 with the full schedule and pricing TBA.
